

RIGHT TO VOTE OF BRITISH CITIZENS ON THE LOCAL ELECTIONS ON 28th MAY 2023

Are British citizens allowed to vote on the next local elections?

Yes, because there is an agreement between Spain and the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, signed in Madrid on the 21st January 2019, which recognises the right of British citizens residing in Spain to vote and to stand as a candidate.

Which requirements do they need to meet in order to vote?

- 1. Be 18 years or older on polling day and not being removed from the right to vote.**
- 2. Be registered on the Municipal Census (Padrón)**
- 3. Be enrolled on the Electoral Census of Foreign Residents in Spain**
- 4. To have legal residence in Spain (TIE or Green card) and have been resident for at least 3 consecutive years.**

How can I enrol on the Electoral Census of Foreign Residents in Spain?

The application for enrolment must be submitted within the established time limit:

- **From 1st December 2022 to 15th January 2023.**

For this purpose, at the end of November, the Electoral Census Office sent a communication to all British citizens who meet the requirements, with their personal and residence details pre-printed, including a code (CTT) that enables them to register online.

How can I formally enrol?

a) On Internet with the INE electronic site <https://sede.ine.gob.es/>, identifying yourself with the cl@ve system and selecting the registration application option, or if you do not have this system, you may access with your NIE and the CTT code included in the communication.

b) Or sending by post (postage free) the signed answering document to the Provincial Delegation of the Electoral Census Office in the envelope that you will receive together with the communication,

If you don't receive the letter, but you think that you meet the requirements please contact the OAC Office at the Town Hall, we will help you and register you on the electoral roll.
