" Exploring Ocean Worlds



We now have tantalising evidence that deep oceans of liquid water exist beneath the icy crusts of moons and dwarf planets in our solar system.

This raises the question of the **potential habita-bility of these extra-terrestrial environments**, as life as we know it depends on the presence of liquid water. Two of the Galilean moons in the Jupiter system, Europa and Ganymede, are thought to harbour such underground oceans.
